ease of use

The earliest reference to hair removal comes from ancient Egypt. Egyptian hieroglyphics describe how slave girls serving Pharaoh were expected to remove their body hair. Sugaring is one of the oldest forms of hair removal and at its simplest, sugar, lemon and water were used in the making of the sugaring paste.

Phâro has enhanced this technique and the product has been modernized and perfected to be suitable for Professional Salon and Spa use. The Phâro logo uses the hieroglyphic image of water to emphasize the water soluble, natural base with skin enhancers that makes this product infinitely superior to waxing products.

The Phâro Sugaring Gel formula contains skin enhancers with Manuka honey, Kiwifruit, Aloe Vera and Lemon juice. Manuka honey is rich in protein, minerals and vitamins with antibacterial properties to protect and heal sensitive skin. The gel has a captivating sweet aroma of Manuka honey, adding a new dimension to the hair removal experience while delivering superior results.

Pure and Natural. Natural formulation, free from solvents and harsh additives. Phâro Sugaring Gel is made from NATURAL INGREDIENTS with no testing on animals. It is made from food grade materials!

Economical. Water soluble formulation makes cleaning simple, eliminating the necessity for expensive post-waxing solvents. Excellent coverage results in cost savings for the salon.

More comfort. Adheres strongly to hair NOT skin, resulting in significantly less discomfort.

Water soluble. Washes off in warm water! You will never ruin your equipment, bed, floors and clients clothes.

Great on sensitive skin. The natural formulation is free from rosins and washes off in warm water. No harsh chemical cleanup.

Hygienic. Non sterilized equipment can be one of the biggest causes of post waxing infection. Phâro spatulas, eyebrow applicators, roller heads and strips are all sterilized for the safety of clients.

Sugaring will not burn the skin.

Unlike waxing products which must be heated to a high temperature, Phâro Sugaring Gel can be applied at slightly above room temperature effectively preventing any possibility of burning or scarring. Lower temperature application also prevents swelling and breakdown of the underlying connective tissue makes sugaring an ideal hair removal method on delicate areas, especially lip and brow areas and on spider veins and varicose veins.

Sugaring does not adhere to the skin.

Resin-based waxing products adhere to both hair and skin which may result in the lifting/removal of live skin cells, making hair removal extremely painful.

Phâro Sugaring Gel adheres only to hair, eliminating fears of skin lifting and ensuring a more comfortable hair removal experience, even when skin conditions like psoriasis and eczema exist. The Phâro Sugaring Gel also contains Manuka honey which is rich in protein, minerals and vitamins with anti-bacterial properties to protect and heal sensitive skin.

Sugaring reduces broken and ingrown hairs.

One of the most common problems waxers face is early regrowth due to broken hairs. Waxing can leave 15-30% breakage behind. Since wax hardens on the hair, it has the tendency to break the hair off at the surface, rather than pull it out.

The Phâro Sugaring Gel wraps around the hair shaft making it pliable, while seeping below the mouth of the follicle and lubricating the hair to make the hair removal experience more complete and gentle.

Sugaring is more sanitary.

Cross contamination in a waxing room is always a danger, since bacteria will grow inside a wax jar. Phâro Sugaring Gel is hypoallergenic and non-comedogenic. Sugar is often used to heal wounds, promote healing, and help control cross contamination. Since Phâro Sugaring Gel has a high concentration of sugar, it resists the growth of bacteria.

sugaring versus waxing

Natural NZ formulation	All wax products contain rosins, even those claiming to contain 'natural ingredients'

Skin is left feeling soft and clean, even before aftercare	Irritated skin and solvent based cleaners leaves clients usually feeling uncomfortable for an extended period of time
